RULES FOR MERIT GRANT FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION - 2012

1. One Merit Grant in the amount of \$500.00 is available from the National Department Polish Legion of American Veterans, U.S.A., Ladies Auxiliary.
2. The Merit Grant is available to students between 15 and 25 years of age who have a learning disability, physical disability, or an emotional disability with the purpose of allowing them to continue their education. Need will be considered. **Recipient is eligible to receive this Grant Only Once.**
3. Applicant must be a son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, niece, nephew or step-child of a current active member of the Polish Legion of American Veterans, U.S.A. or their Ladies Auxiliary.
4. The completed application must be returned to the State Department Scholarship Officer for verification of eligibility and completeness. If there is no State Department in your state, application should be sent to the Post/Chapter Scholarship Officer, Post Commander or Chapter President (to verify eligibility and completeness of the application) who, in turn, will forward application to the National Department (after verification).
